As Christmas approaches, I am thinking of the perfect gift for the kids for whom we are praying. It is very rare, very extravagant and extremely expensive. The idea began to formulate as I thought about the unrest in the hearts and lives of our teens today. The anxiety can run the gamut from worry about grades, appearance, peer approval and future plans, to pivotal moral decisions of substance abuse, sexual activity, and gang participation. Broken homes bring the turmoil of living by different standards in multiple addresses. Many kids live in genuine fear as drug activity, crime and many parental love interests move in and out of the home.

A young couple working with the Fellowship of Christian Athletes in an urban setting tells of inviting teens into their home only to have them fall asleep within minutes of arriving. The quiet, safe haven provided temporary rest from the chaos of their daily lives. I have become aware of teens so plagued by fears that they must be medicated nightly in order to sleep; often nightmares steal the rest from that short slumber. There are numerous stories of several kids sleeping in the same bed while blaring televisions and “cranked up” stereos keep them from sleeping most nights.

While the prince of this dark world presents the opportunities for and consequences of sin in many different ways in different neighborhoods, the need for rest and peace remains in each and every teen across our land. You and I have access to the one and only Person who can bring the gift of true peace and rest into the chaos that has been described. Peace is rare and costly, but our merciful Father has paid the great price with the precious blood of His holy Son. The weight of death itself and the heavy mass of the sin of the world drove Jesus deep into the grave—satan bruised His heel.¹ Yet, the power of our Might God raised Him from those depths to new life, seating Him in the highest heaven at the right hand of the Father where He now rules over all authorities and principalities.

Jesus broke the chains of death and bought the **gift of true peace: forgiven sin and an intimate relationship with God Himself!** Join me in asking God to send His Holy Spirit to offer the Prince of Peace, the merciful Savior as the most special gift these kids will ever receive. With men it is impossible, but with God, bringing light and life, order and beauty, peace and rest, into utter darkness and chaos is very possible—See the first chapter of Genesis!

Sunday – Fear of God
