May 1 – July 31, 2012

“Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in a time of need.” (Hebrews 4:16) We must help in this time of enormous need for there are giants in our land! (1)

In a recent interview with *Rolling Stone* magazine’s Rob Sheffield, the 25-year-old writer, director and star of the HBO series, *Girls!*, sums up the miseries of youth: “drugs, diseases, abortions, disastrous jobs, worse sex...” “The brilliance of *Girls!*,” Sheffield writes, “is how these young American’s have already gotten all the hopes and desires trampled out of them...these ladies have no aspirations, not even the pretentious and unrealistic kind...they’re not working on any dream at all.” The episodes are filled with nudity and “awkward sex” and at one point the thing that gives the star “something to be excited about,” is accompanying her friend to have an abortion, stating, “This is the first abortion I’ve ever been to!” “The star never smiles, but mostly contemplates the bad move she’s just made and the horrific one she’s about to make,” states Sheffield. “I may be the voice of my generation,” the star insists as she visits with Sheffield who concludes, “The scary part is that she might be right.”(2) While this may not be a perfect depiction of the youth in your hometown, this is the type of entertainment that may very likely be searing their hearts and minds as they watch.

Bullying is another giant I’ve become aware of recently. *Bullycam*, a video recently shown at a local film festival, is a very graphic portrayal of severe bullying inspired by the true story of 15-year-old Phoebe Prince who committed suicide after enduring months of brutality. Six teenagers were prosecuted for crimes including statutory rape and civil rights violations of the beautiful girl who had recently moved to the US from Ireland. A google search gives multiple sites for bullying statistics.

I was reminded in Isaiah 45 of God’s intense power when He promises Cyrus, the King of Persia, His “anointed” “I will go before you and level the exalted places, I will break in pieces the doors of bronze and cut through the bars of iron,. I will give you the treasures of darkness and the hoards in secret places, that you may know that it is I, the Lord, the God of Israel, who call you by your name...Shower, O heavens, from above, and let the clouds rain down righteousness; let the earth open, that salvation and righteousness may bear fruit; let the earth cause them both to sprout, I the Lord have created it.” We are reminded of God’s tender promise in Jeremiah 32:40-41, “ I will put the fear of Me in their hearts, that they may not turn from me. I will rejoice in doing them good and I will plant them in this land in faithfulness, *with all my heart and all my soul.*” God gave all of His heart and soul when He sent His Son, whose death destroyed the one who has the power of death and delivered those subjected to a life of slavery to sin. (Heb. 2:14-15.) We must never give up! He is willing and able to save!
