For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved

Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.

And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. John 3:16-19

As we saw the son in Luke 15 who "loved darkness rather than light" and squandered all the inheritance his father had graciously given him, we are reminded that even the most heinous lifestyle is not beyond the love and mercy of our Lord. We must have the mind of Christ as we face each day crushed by the senseless evil that surrounds us knowing that we are not without hope.

We can't imagine the "pig pens" in which some of those for whom we pray are living at the moment. The reckless lives they have chosen have left them far from the Father's house, hungry and lonely. We must pray that the desperate situation in which they find themselves would cause them to come to their senses and make their way home to the loving Father through His son. We do have an Elder Brother who left His place at the right hand of the Father to rescue all who have chosen darkness over light and life. This "First-born" searches for his lost siblings like the shepherd searches high and low for that lost sheep. And as an "elder" sibling whose heart is one with the Father, we must continue to bring our students daily to the throne of grace, pleading that they would come to know what love the Father has lavished on them, that they could be called children of GOD!

The time you spend on your knees in prayer is not in vain, it may save the lives of many! Never ever give up!

## Prayer Guide

In this prayer guide you will find a scripture that we will be using in our prayers for our children each day. The major theme for each day is given below.

### **Sunday – Fear of God**

That they will fear the Lord and see His character

### **Monday – Salvation**
