As I walked past the T.V., I was stunned to see scenes from an episode of the popular sit com “Glee” depicting explicit homosexual behavior among teenagers. The show whose title once led me to recall a nostalgic time of bobby socks and poodle skirts, where the high school Glee Club was all about “good clean fun,” now revealed two young men engaged in a long mouth to mouth kiss followed by a scene with two female cheerleaders groping each other as they lay in bed. That afternoon, I was further heart-broken when a friend called describing the agony her family is going through as their beautiful 15-year-old has come to the conclusion she is a lesbian.

We are indeed engaged in true spiritual warfare as our society daily calls evil good and good evil. Exchanging the truth for a lie, we have embraced the notion that same-sex attraction is “normal,” a genetic predisposition, rather than a fleeting juvenile thought or period of adolescent sexual confusion.

The “Gay-Straight Alliance” club phenomenon has exploded in recent years growing from 40 clubs in 1998 to at least 3000 clubs in 2005. As Peter describes in 1Peter 2, the creators of these clubs promise freedom, but they themselves are slaves of corruption. Promoting a positive portrayal of homosexuality, bisexuality and transgender lifestyles among students, the dangers of the homosexual lifestyle are glossed over. Studies continue to show AIDS and STD’s as risk factors for those living in the gay lifestyle. Substance abuse and domestic violence (48% lesbians and 38% gay males report physical abuse compared to 28% in heterosexual relationships) round out the top three physical health hazards of this lifestyle, not to mention the self-doubt, low self esteem and self destructive behavior that are also seen.

I implore you to realize the magnitude of the reality that our teenagers are being taken captive to this lie in schools all over our country. This is a lifestyle of lies and deception; of death and darkness. BUT GOD in His infinite mercy can exchange light for the darkness, truth for the lies, sweet for the bitter and life for the dying. Please pray that the child you’ve “adopted” will come to know the unconditional love of Christ. That God’s grace and peace will fill his/her life as they come to know the truth that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all...That they would realize they were fearfully and wonderfully made and that they are Christ’s workmanship, created for His pleasure.
