I am currently taking a 2-year "Biblical Training for Christian Leaders" course through my church and a highlight for me has been to hear the personal testimonies of my fellow students and teachers. While we all come from different "places" in life, the climax of every story is Christ revealing Himself to us at some point and beginning a life-long process of drawing us close to Him and transforming us into His likeness. Some come to know Jesus as a young child through parents who exhibit the truth of the gospel in their daily lives, holding the Scriptures as the basis for that truth. Others have come to the Lord, in spite of their upbringing, through the influence of extended family members, friends, teachers, coaches or "circumstances." In any case, Jesus tells us in John 6:32 that "no one comes to Me unless the Father draws him." That's what we are praying: that God will invade the life of our "adopted student" and draw him/her to Himself.

Kirsten Powers formerly served in the administration of Bill Clinton, and is now a Democratic commentator at Fox News. In the November, 2014, issue of *Christianity Today*, she shares how God invaded her life, hearing the prayers and using the influence of a friend, and converted her to faith in Christ. Kirsten begins, "...If there was one thing in which I was completely secure, it was that I would never adhere to any religion—especially to evangelical Christianity, which I held in particular contempt." and completes with, "I remember walking into the Bible study. I had a knot in my stomach. In my mind, only weirdoes and zealots went to Bible studies. I don't remember what was said that day. All I know is that when I left, everything had changed. I'll never forget standing outside that apartment on the Upper East Side and saying to myself, "It's true. It's completely true." The world looked entirely different, like a veil had been lifted off it. I had not an iota of doubt. I was filled with indescribable joy. The horror of the prospect of being a devout Christian crept back in almost immediately. I spent the next few months doing my best to wrestle away from God. It was pointless. Everywhere I turned, there he was. Slowly there was less fear and more joy. The Hound of Heaven had pursued me and caught me—whether I liked it or not..."

We must never give up! Pray that our mighty God will "pursue and catch" our students and never let them go.

Sunday – Fear of God

That they will fear the Lord and see His character

Monday – Salvation

That they would know and love Christ as their Savior

Wednesday – Hatred of Sin

That they would desire the right friends and be protected from the wrong friends and crowd

Saturday – Mate & Purity

That they and their future mate will be kept pure for marriage
