May 1 – July 31, 2014

A friend's son began having difficulty completing his schoolwork during his early years of elementary school. Reading was especially challenging and tedious for this diligent student. After extensive testing, it was discovered that there was a problem with visual perception causing the boy to see only a couple of words at a time. He was required not only to learn to read words, but to remember the first couple of words in a sentence which would become blurred as his eyes moved to the next couple of words; all the while trying to keep his place on the page that looked to him like a bowl of alphabet soup-foolishness. Surprisingly, the treatment was a simple but very expensive one. Glasses fitted with pale blue tinted lenses brought clarity to the page and opened a whole new world of understanding for him.

In 2 Corinthians 3, Paul tells us that only in Christ can the "veil" be taken away. And in 1 Corinthians 2:9-10, "What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard and what no human mind has conceived"—the things God has prepared for those who love Him—these are the things God has revealed to us by His Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God." For the church at Ephesus, Paul prayed that "the glorious Father may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know Him better...that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which He has called you..."

Like the visually impaired boy, "the person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit" 1 Corinthians 2:14.

The Scriptures, telling the truth of creation, of sin, of God's love and salvation in Christ, are just words on a page to those who do not have the Holy Spirit, the priceless "special glasses," fitted to bring Spiritual understanding. Let's be extravagant in our prayers as we plead that somehow, somehow our students will obtain a Bible and that Our Father will send the Holy Spirit of Christ to open their eyes to their sin and God's unfathomable love and grace as written in His Word. May God richly pour His Spirit on us all!

Sunday – Fear of God
