Thanksgiving, Christmas, New Years

As the chill of autumn sets in, thoughts of hayrides and bonfires for roasting hotdogs and marshmallows flood the mind. The warmth, the light and the excitement of the fire provides the backdrop for storytelling, games, dancing and all kinds of “good clean fun!” The trench and the rocks encircling the deep fire pit provide the barrier that keeps the crowd safe. Let a few embers cross this border, and the ensuing wildfire would be devastating, changing lives forever.

God has set boundaries for our safety in life as well. Within the boundary of marriage a man and woman are allowed to experience a love and intimacy that is surpassed only by the relationship between a believer and the Triune God. The Song of Solomon tells the beautiful story of this love as it unfolds: the meeting, the courtship, the marriage and even resolution of conflicts within the marriage. The longing to know and be known by one who has been designed to complement and complete, is met within the safety of a sacred promise and a legal contract. The passionate fires of sexual intimacy are safely contained within this boundary of marriage. While the enemy has convinced our society that this notion is a fairytale and that fornication, multiple sexual partners, homosexual relationships and pornography are harmless, we must fervently pray that our teens will hear the truth that this devastating wildfire raging outside the bonds of marriage will destroy their lives.

Pam Stenzel in her book, *Nobody Told Me*, shares the personal stories of many teens that wish they had known the truth about engaging in sex outside the boundary of marriage. One of every three females in the US gets pregnant before age 20. Less than one-third of teens who begin their families before age 18 ever earn a high school diploma and only 1.5% earn a college degree before age 30. The child born has 64% chance of growing up in poverty. One-third of pregnant teens choose to have an abortion. While contraceptives promise to prevent pregnancy and drop abortion rates, they are no protection against the more than twenty-six sexually transmitted diseases (STD). In the next 24 hours 10,000 teens will discover they have an STD some of which cause cancer, sterility and even death. Certain STDs never leave the body and can resurface many times throughout life. Depression runs so high among sexually active teens that doctors are advised to have this at-risk population screened. Sexually active boys are nine times more likely and teen girls three times more likely to attempt suicide than their peers who maintain abstinence.

We must plead with our Father to pour His Holy Spirit over these teens, opening their eyes to the truth that He knows them intimately and loves them with so great a love that He gave His only Son, who willingly died for them; that the power that raised Jesus from the grave will give them a brand new life full of meaning and purpose and hope. Never give up!

Prayer Guide

In this prayer guide you will find a scripture that we will be using in our prayers for our students each day. The major theme for each day is given below.

Sunday – Fear of God

That they will fear the Lord and see His character

Monday – Salvation

That they would know and love Christ as their Savior

Tuesday – Wisdom

That God would give them a heart of wisdom and that they would put on righteousness and know right from wrong

Wednesday – Hatred of Sin

That they would be protected from the evil one. That they would hate sin and be caught when they do sin

That they and their future mate will be kept pure for marriage
