Psalm 8:2 tells us that God, “through the praise of children and infants,” has “established a stronghold against His enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger.” Yet, through broken people, the enemy is trying to turn the tables and silence the voice of our infants and children. Every year in the U.S., 1.2 million abortions take babies before they can catch their first breath. In 2014, 702,000 child abuse cases were confirmed in the U.S.; over 58,000 children were sexually abused¹. The number of children sexually exploited in the U.S., or at risk of being exploited, annually is between 100,000 and 300,000.² We are to take no part in deeds done in the darkness, but expose them. It is shameful to even speak of such things that are done in secret, (Eph. 5:11-12) but in an effort to rescue these precious babes, we must take a glimpse at this dark, devastating part of our world and ask our Father to shine His light in the darkness, and rescue them from the fowler’s snare.

--Sex trafficking, fueled by pornography, is the second-largest criminal enterprise in the world, second only to the drug trade. In the U.S. a victim can earn \$168,000 per year for the pimp who often has four to six victims. In Atlanta, a hub for sex trafficking where victims are forced to sell themselves between eight and 12 times a night, pimps can rake in \$33,000 a week.

--Predators seek to exploit genuine needs for love and affection as well as basic needs such as food, clothing, and shelter. They prey upon children from all walks of life who are needy, insecure, anxious, lonely and vulnerable. Girls are typically lured into “the life” at 12 to 14 years old, boys start at 11 to 13 years old.

--Sometimes victims are runaways looking for the love and stability they cannot find at home where often they have been abused from a young age. Sometimes “friends” trick them into the trade with the promise of quick and easy money. Others are prostituted by parents to pay the bills. Some are homeless and need shelter.

--Pimps are expert manipulators, sometimes spending weeks and months courting victims online or in person with a listening ear, promises of love, fancy “dates” and gifts.

--Traffickers actively work to break down their victims’ psyche and develop control over them through a combination of intense manipulation, feigned affection, brutal violence, isolation, drug dependence and emotional abuse. These children are slaves and are often hidden in plain sight.

--Unless they are rescued, life expectancy once children are forced into this life of prostitution, is seven years due to drug use, STDs, suicide, and homicide. Leaving the “life” is most difficult and those who are rescued from this slavery will return unless there is treatment and healing that only God can give. Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder is universal among sex trafficked victims

These facts have come from the many sources and stories I’ve heard and read. (Contact us for a complete source list) The student for whom you pray could be a target or a victim. While this horrible reality seems insurmountable, nothing is impossible with God who cleanses and restores. He brings life from death and beauty from ashes. Never give up!
