God has always been. God is beyond anything we can imagine. He is creator and sustainer of the universe—from the microscopic to the highest heavens—and God has uniquely created people for His glory and for his divine purposes. He is sovereign. He has absolute control over all things and He is in the process of accomplishing His will regarding human history and each individual person. We have the privilege of seeing God's Sovereign hand, not only in Creation, but in the lives of His people as well.

Hadassah, a young Jewess created to be exceptionally beautiful, was an orphan, raised by her single relative, Mordecai during Israel's captivity in Babylon. (Esther 2) While living as a slave in a pagan country, Hadassah was snatched from her safe home and dropped into the harem of a pagan King, close to 20 years her senior. In God's plan, this innocent teen, became Queen Esther. Though her dreams might have been to leave her father and mother and cling to a godly husband, her submission to the Sovereign hand of God throughout her young life and her brave actions saved a nation and led the Jewish people to a new level of influence in Susa.

Rahab, unlike Hadassah, was born a Canaanite, far from the chosen people of God. (Joshua 2) And, unlike Hadassah, for whatever reason—possibly poverty, forced by the authorities—she was a prostitute who ran an inn on the wall of the city. We do know that no little girl dreams of becoming a prostitute and we see glimpses of Rahab's keen awareness of, and hope in the God of Israel. It seems God opened her heart to the possibility of one day leaving this pagan darkness. She had heard of the Red Sea parting as the Israelites fled captivity and of the defeat of Sihon and Og as they entered the Promised land after 40 years of wandering. The day finally came when Rahab declared her faith to the spies and arranged for her rescue and that of her family. She proclaimed, "your God is the supreme God" (NLT). Not just an earthly God, but the One who "rules the heavens above and the earth below!" Rahab and her family were snatched from the rubble and can be found in the lineage of Christ.

There are countless teens who find themselves in places that are not of their choosing, far away from the people of God. Will you pray for God's Sovereign plan to unfold in the life of your student, they will catch a glimpse of the God who rules the heavens and the earth and will be snatched from the rubble of their dark lives?

## Prayer Guide

In this prayer guide you will find a scripture that we will be using in our prayers for our children each day. The major theme for each day is given below.

### **Sunday – Fear of God**

That they will fear the Lord and see His character

### **Monday – Salvation**

That they would know and love Christ as their Savior
