God so loved that He sent His only Son, not to condemn, but to save. Jesus came to take away sin and give abundant and eternal life. John tells us that as they headed to Galilee from Judea, Jesus *needed* to go through Samaria. From eternity past the Father had made a divine appointment and Jesus had to keep it. His disciples had gone into the city to buy food when Jesus sat, tired and thirsty, by a well just as a woman came to fill her jar. The Creator of water itself was thirsty and asked *This Samaritan Woman* for a drink. His lips drank from a water-filled vessel drawn by the hands of a woman who had to come in the heat of the day because her reputation kept her from coming in the morning with the other women.

It was not with a condemning finger pointed at the woman, but with a heart of love and mercy that Jesus brought her sin to light and revealed that He was the long-awaited Messiah, the Savior of the world. He offered her His very Spirit-Living Water-that would cleanse and satisfy her longings forever. She believed Him and bravely ran to tell the entire town. She became the well, springing up to eternal life to all those around her and they all came to meet Jesus.

I'm wondering if the town's people were coming to the well just about the time His disciples returned with the food. Jesus told them to look at the fields that were white for harvest. The fields in our schools are white for harvest and this true story reminds me of the many divine appointments that have been made with our students. Perhaps the student for whom you pray is a believer and needs courage to approach a student who may be weighed down with the burden of sin, loneliness or feeling ostracized. Asking a needy student if there is room at the lunch table could open a conversation much like that of Jesus with the Samaritan woman. Pray that the Holy Spirit would lead believing students to the places they *need* to be and the conversations they *need* to have each day. Pray for a great harvest of students who, themselves, will become wells springing up to eternal life to those around them. Who knows what group, or team, or class will come to Jesus because of one divine appointment? With God, all things are possible! (John 4)

## Prayer Guide

In this prayer guide you will find a scripture that we will be using in our prayers for our students each day. The major theme for each day is given below.

### **Sunday – Fear of God**

### **Monday – Salvation**

### **Friday – Friends**

That they would desire the right friends and be protected from the wrong friends and crowd

### **Saturday – Mate & Purity**

That they and their future mate will be kept pure for marriage
