In his book Outliers, Malcom Gladwell gives insight into the success of the world's best and brightest people, the famous and most talented. We may think these "outliers," who are "off the charts" in their fields, were just innately smarter, more athletic or gifted. But, as it turns out, along with innate abilities and hard work, the opportunities one is given, or not given, play a huge role in his or her success or lack thereof. These opportunities include: being in the right place at the right time, resources in the home (was there money for books, travel, summer camps?), education level of parents and if they were present in the home to encourage summer reading and homework completion. Even the time of year a child was born was key to opportunities afforded them. Champion Hockey players in Canada, for example, were much more likely to have birthdays just after the cutoff date of January 1st for peewee team eligibility, allowing them an entire year of development over those born just before the cutoff. From their earliest hockey experience, they were bigger and more coordinated affording them spots on select teams, and then professional teams. This was true of children whose birthdates were just after the cutoff date for school admission as well. Kids who were born in September had an entire year of development over their classmates who were born in August. The older kids were more confident and often selected for "gifted" programs or starting spots on athletic teams, allowing them more opportunities for college admission and scholarships later on.

There is an opportunity Gladwell didn't discuss in his book. What is the effect of prayer on a student's life? What happens when a believer—a child of God—goes to his Father and asks that He intervene in a life? When we pray, "our Father in heaven, make Your name hallowed in the life of my student," or "Your kingdom come, and Your will be done in this student's life," how does the trajectory of that life change? What happens when we pray for the resources—"give our student his daily bread"—required to succeed in God's plan? What eternal plan is set in motion when we ask God to deliver the teen from the forces of darkness, from the enemy's plan for his life, and to bring this student to a point of conviction of sin, not just feeling bad about getting caught, but truly grieving over the fact that he has hurt God? The effective, fervent prayers of righteous people accomplish so much! (James 5:16b) God is able to do exceedingly abundantly beyond all that we ask or think according to the power that works in us. (Eph.3:20) By faith we press on knowing that one day our faith will be sight and we will see success—that our student was a delight to God and a blessing to others! All Glory to God, He is doing great things! Never give up!

Sunday – Fear of God
