Sources of a “restless heart,” or anxiety, in teens can range from worry about grades, appearance, peer approval and future plans, to pivotal moral decisions regarding substance abuse, gender confusion, sexual activity, and gang participation. Broken homes bring insecurity and the turmoil of living by different standards in different homes. A young couple working with the Fellowship of Christian Athletes in an urban setting tells of inviting teens into their home only to have them fall asleep within minutes of arriving. The quiet, safe haven provided temporary rest from the chaos of their daily lives.

While the prince of this dark world presents the opportunities for and consequences of sin in many different ways in different neighborhoods, the need for rest and peace remains in each and every teen. You and I have access to the one and only Person who can bring the gift of true rest into their chaos. Peace and hope are rare and costly, but our merciful Father has paid the great price with the precious blood of His perfect Son. The weight of death and sin took Jesus through mocking and suffering, and finally to the cross and the grave. Yet, the power of our mighty God raised Him from those depths to new life, seating Him in heaven at the right hand of the Father where He now rules over all authorities and principalities.

Jesus broke the chains of sin and death and bought the gift of true peace: forgiven sin and an intimate relationship with God Himself! He invites our teens to, “Come to Me all you who are weary and heavy laden, and I will give you rest, take My yoke upon you and learn from Me. For I am humble and gentle, and you will find rest for your souls.”¹ Join me in asking God to send His Prince of Peace, through His Holy Spirit to these teens. With men it is impossible, but with God, bringing light and life, order and beauty, hope and resolve, peace and rest, into darkness and chaos is very possible. Thank you for your prayers!
