Jesus' prayer for His followers recorded in John 17 gives direction in praying for our teens today. Jesus asked His Father to protect His followers "by the power of Your name—the name You gave Me—so that they may be one as We are one." We first ask the Father to draw our teens out of the world, to Himself through His saving grace. That they would **know** Him as their Lord and Savior. We pray that they will be "one" with other believing students (though very different in personality, talents and interests), united in a bond of love—a genuine brotherly relationship that can buffer the tempting and harsh realities of the world.

Iesus also asked that believers be "protected from the evil one." While we have been set free from satan's ownership, the enemy prowls looking for someone to devour. Paul speaks of a struggle with the flesh and with the world in Galatians 5 when he states, "It was for freedom that Christ set you free, therefore keep standing firm and do not be subject again to a voke of slavery... For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision (externals) means anything, but faith working through love." And later, "For we were called to freedom, brethren; only do not turn your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another." Paul concludes chapter 5 with a contrast in the works of the flesh: "adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries and the like" and the fruits of the Spirit: "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and selfcontrol."

Iesus prayed that God would "sanctify them by the truth; Your Word is truth." We pray our teens would be sanctified—become more and more conformed to the image of Christ. The Greek thought in this word sanctify, hagiazo, is "to withdraw from fellowship with the world by first gaining fellowship with God." In John 4 the Samaritan woman, parched by the ways of the world, was offered living water by One who knew her intimately. This "Living Water," fellowship with Jesus Himself, would not only satisfy her every longing, but would become a "fountain, springing up to eternal life" to those around her. We must pray diligently that the Holy Spirit of the Living God would woo our students to His well of life and that they would go there frequently to fellowship with Him. That their relationships with other believers would be genuine and infectious. That they would be convicted of sin and be refreshed through repentance, and that the spiritual thirsts of those around them would be whetted from the fountain of their changed lives. Never give up!

Prayer Guide

In this prayer guide you will find a scripture that we will be using in our prayers for our children each day. The major theme for each day is given below.

Sunday - Fear of God

That they will fear the Lord and see His character

Monday - Salvation

That they would know and love Christ as their Savior

Tuesday – Wisdom

That God would give them a heart of wisdom and that they would put on righteousness and know right from wrong

Wednesday - Hatred of Sin

That they would be protected from the evil one. That they would hate sin and be caught when they do sin

Thursday – Submission

That they would respect and submit to the authority over them, and find joy in obedience

Friday – Friends

That they would desire the right friends and be protected from the wrong friends and crowd

Saturday - Mate & Purity

That they and their future mate will be kept pure for marriage
