Reading about a local student taking part in this year's Texas 4000 brought back memories of our son's 2008 ride. I wrote about that experience in that summer's prayer guide: "This summer a group of college students from the University of Texas will be riding their bicycles from Austin, Texas, to Anchorage, Alaska, to benefit cancer research. Each of the thirty members of the Texas 4000 team have raised over \$1.00 for each of the 4000+ miles they will be traveling and have logged over 1000 miles on their bikes in preparation. Many of the participants are keeping a journal of this experience which can be found on the Texas 4000 website. After one three-day trip, a student described riding 100 miles, enduring stinging sand from a whirlwind, and rushing to load the bikes into a trailer during a downpour. He wrote, "when I began the trip, I considered these people my teammates; now, they are my friends." This intense experience of sharing joys and trials has brought a kindered spirit which will last for some time.

The road traveled through the teen years can be one storm after another. Friendships are formed in these times that leave lasting impressions. Many decisions are influenced by friends and peers. Jesus who created our teens for His purposes wants to be their Friend (John 15:15). He wants those teens who are believers to be His friend and to love those around them like He loves them. Stephen was one who loved those around him more than he loved himself. In Acts 6 we read of Stephen's wisdom and faith as he served the Greek widows each day. Later, though falsely accused, he continued to love and speak the truth of God's love and Jesus' death and resurrection for the salvation of those who would ultimately stone him. As Stephen was dying he looked up to see Jesus STANDING at His Father's right hand. Jesus stood up for His friend who had followed Him even to the death. And nearby, a young man named Saul saw Stephen's faithfulness (a seed planted). Later, Saul too would come face to face with Jesus—blinded by the Light of the One who would transform him forever.

As we pray specifically on Fridays for our teens' friendships, pray that believing students will cling to Jesus as their best friend. That our Lord will draw them to Himself through His Word, and that the truth and joy they receive from spending time with Him will spill over to those around them. Pray that God will open the eyes and hearts of unbelieving students to His light shining through the consistent Godly behavior of Christians around them. Ask that God would use the storms of life to platform His strength and presence in the lives of believers; that watching students would search for that strength and presence and find JESUS, and make Him their best friend forever!"

Prayer Guide

In this prayer guide you will find a scripture that we will be using in our prayers for our children each day. The major theme for each day is given below.

Sunday – Fear of God

That they will fear the Lord and see His character

Monday – Salvation

That they would know and love Christ as their Lord and Savior

Tuesday – Wisdom

That God would give them a heart of wisdom and that they would put on righteousness and know right from wrong

Wednesday – Hatred of Sin

That they would be protected from the evil one. That they would hate sin and be caught when they do sin

Thursday – Submission

That they would respect and submit to the authority over them, and find joy in obedience

Friday – Friends

That they would desire the right friends and be protected from the wrong friends and crowd

Saturday – Mate & Purity

That they and their future mate will be kept pure for marriage
